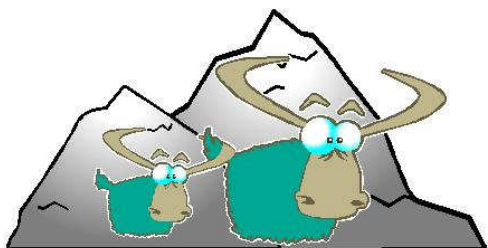

Reminder Re: Overnight Visits

As you and your Little Brother make big plans for this summer keep in mind agency policy about overnight visits. As per Big Brothers and Sisters of Canada's Child Safety Standards, no overnight visits are permitted in the first year of the match. After a match has been successful for at least one year overnight visits can be no more than three nights in a row, and can occur no more than four times a year. **An Overnight Consent Form must be completed by the Big Brother, Parent/Guardian, & Caseworker prior to any overnights so plan ahead!**

All overnight visits must take place within Canada.
