## OVERNIGHT OUTINGS

As Bigs and Littles are busy making exciting plans for the summer keep in mind Big Brothers Big Sisters of Canada's Overnight policy:

No overnight outings are allowed in the first year of a match.

After the match has been successful for at least one year overnight visits are permitted with the advance written and signed consent of the parent, agency and volunteer. Overnight Consent forms are available at the office.

Overnight visits are limited to no longer than three consecutive nights and no more than four such visits per year.

These restrictions are waived only where:

-the Little Brother is 16 years of age and older AND has been successfully matched with the same Big Brother/Couple Match for at least one year

Overnight visits may not occur outside of Canada UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE.
